- Phase 1: Orientation Sessions

  - With the cooperating principals
  - With the cooperating teacher
- Phase 2: Observation and building relationship
  - Observation of Classes
  - Building relationship with your cooperating teacher, learners and other teaching support personnel.

- Phase 3: On site tasks
  - Writing Learning Plans
  - Creating instructional materials
  - Constructing assessment tools
  - Participating in school activities
  - Doing Daily teaching tasks
- Phase 4: Final Demonstration and accomplishing exit forms
  - Executing Final Demonstration Lessons
  - Accomplish Evaluation forms and exit Clearance
