1. Short title, extent, Commencement and application:

1. This act may be called the Apprentices Act 1961

2. It extends whole of india.

3. It shall come into force on such date as the central government may, by notification in the official gazettee, appoint, and different dates may be appointed for different states.

4. The provisions of this act shall not apply to  
- (a) any area or to any industry in any area unless the central govt notification in the official Gazettee specifies that area or industry as an area or industry to which the said shall apply with effect from such date as may be mentioned notification.

(b) any such special apprenticeship scheme for imparting training to apprentices as may any be notified by the central govt in the official Gazettee.

2. Definition: In this act, unless the context otherwise requires:

(a) "All India Council" means the All India Council of Technical Education established by resolution of the govt of India in ministry of education NO: F 16-10/44 E 111. dated 30th 1945.

"apprentice" means a person who is undergoing apprenticeship training in pursuance of a contract of apprenticeship

"apprenticeship training" means a course of training in any industry or establishment undergone in pursuance of a contract of apprenticeship and prescribed terms and conditions which may be different for different categories of apprentices.

(b) Apprenticeship Adviser means the Central Apprenticeship Adviser under sub sec (1) of sec 26 or state apprenticeship Adviser appointed under sub sec (2) of the state.

(c) "Apprenticeship Council" means the Central Apprenticeship Council or the state apprenticeship council established under sub sec (1) of sec 24.

(d) appropriate govt means in relation to  
(i) the central apprenticeship Council or regional board or  
(ii) the practical training of graduate or
