- Saakshar bharat /adult education


### HISTORICAL OVERVIEW

- In 1947, the Indian government sponsored a variety of programmes to address the problems of illiteracy.
- In 1948-1949. Union government established the University Education Commission to develop proposals to modernize the India education system.
- In 1961, National Council Of Educational Research and Training(NCERT) was formed to advise the government on formulating education policies.

## HISTROCIAL OVERVIEW

- In 1968, first National Policy on Education was formed which called for equalising the educational opportunities to achieve national integrity.
